1. Discussion Regarding Valuation of Properties

There was discussion as to how to set a minimum value for parcels being requested for disposition going forward. Committee members agreed that their discussions going forward should focus on whether or not disposal of the property makes sense for the Town. The Committee agreed to leave the discussion of minimum prices for disposal to the Board of Selectmen, and would not include it in their recommendations going forward.

2. Review of Requests for Disposition

The Committee reviewed the request for disposition of town-owned lots C10 and C11. The Committee previously discussed the merits of this request and agreed it made sense for the town to dispose of it.

Vote: On a motion from Jim Saben, seconded by Brian Gardiner, the Committee voted to recommend the disposition of lots C10 and C11, by a vote of 5-0.
