- Minutes from 4/13/22 approved
- Update from Amanda on Sandy Pond Playground-60% design phase
 - o 90% design phase by 6/10/22-purchase equipment (10-12 weeks)
 - o Bids go out in July of 2022
 - o Construction August-November 2022
 - o Water percolation test on 5/12/22
 - 2 test pits for drainage
 - drywell 14' deep
 - o netting will be required for softball field
 - o fencing/signage/ management plan needed
 - o 2 porta-potties plus existing facilities for site
 - possible park grant to upgrade existing facility to ADA compliance
 - o TMobile and AT&T have lines running through our site
 - o Possible solar lighting
 - Need to establish a new project phasing plan
- Paul Cove reported for pickleball
 - Request increase in players from current 300 to 430-approved unanimously.
 - 80 per day maximum-parking plan submitted
 - signage at end of road indicating "Full Capacity"
 - Current fee is \$25 for residents and \$35 for non-residents
 - Proceeds to purchase windscreens, bleachers, gravel
 - Currentl lighting restrictions to be studied
- Director Howell reported:
 - Flax Pond at 99% capacity
 - o Only 16-17 lifeguards currently(need 40)
 - 90% of guards are not local youths
 - \$17 per hour to start
 - New programs to be offered
 - Stand up paddle boarding and Kayaking for adults
 - Flag football in fall for age 3 to 7th or 8th grade
 - Curling
 - Movies on the beach again this summer
