



Board of Selectmen
Meeting Minutes
March 25, 2014

The regular meeting was called to order at 7:00p.m. in the Town Hall Hearing Room by Chairman Erik Tolley. Selectmen present: Tracy Post, Norm Holcomb, Jim Quirk and Michael Stone. Also Attending: Town Administrator William Hinchey. The Board of Selectmen gave the pledge of allegiance.

2. Standard & Poors Bond Rating

Mr. Hinchey announced, alongside the Town Finance Team, the Standard & Poors Bond Rating for the Town of Yarmouth increase from a AA- to a AA+

Ms. Vida Morris thanked Mike Stone with his efforts to save the Castonguay bird collection. Mr. Hinchey informed the Board that the School Committee voted to take the bird collection off the auction block. Ms. Morris asked about increases for the school budget and the Yarmouth assessment.

Joe Dontrimont, President of MA Rolling Thunder, spoke to the Board about a POW/MIA chair and requested the Board's support in placing a chair at Town Hall. Chairman Tolley apologized that this wasn't an official agenda item. A more formal presentation will be done in the near future.

The Legal Ad was read, and the application was represented by Steve Sorrell and Ray Butler. Mr. Sorrell described the proposed operation which will employ approximately 20 people, open 7 days a week. There are a total of 200 vehicles allowed on the lot and have addressed the site plan review comments. No Public comments were made in favor or against the application.

2. **Discussion**

Last Drink- **Red Face Jack's**

Represented by Att. Peter Lloyd and Ted Zambellis. Chairman Stone reviewed what "Last Drink" is and why a letter to Red Face Jack's was sent to them regarding an alleged offense. Chairman Stone stated that this is not a disciplinary hearing but rather a discussion on the services available to assist the establishment to serve patrons safely and ask what steps the establishment is taking to not appear on the list again. Atty. Lloyd spoke about the steps taken by the establishment to have every employee TIPS certified. In addition, there is a recertification program being held at Red Face Jacks on June 25th for the Restaurant Association which all Red Face Jack's employees will be required to attend. The Board discussed hypothetical scenarios which a bartender can face during a

Mr. Hinchey provided an update on the Bridgewater State University lease, as well as their efforts to collaboratively work with the Cape Cod Community College. Classes expect to begin in LCM January 2015.
