Town of Yarmouth Cape Cod Rail Trail – Phase 2

Phase 2 of the Cape Cod Rail Trail (CCRT) project which is being constructed by MAS Building & Bridge Inc has entered the pile driving stage of construction beginning the week of September 25th. The pile driving activity is expected Monday through Thursday from 7:00 am-6:00 pm for a period of 4 weeks. Phase 2 of the Bike Trail project provides the connecting piece between Yarmouth and the rest of the CCRT and includes an at-grade crossing at North Main Street and new trail to the Bass River Bridge. The Bass River Bridge will not only serve as a pedestrian bridge for the CCRT, but has been designed to also be a tidal restoration project. The existing 60' wide bridge will be widened to 160' to match the existing opening under Route 6. This will improve the ecosystem of the upper Bass River, as well as improve navigation by deepening the channel and reducing the velocities under the bridge.
