LEGAL NOTICE

The Town of Yarmouth Community Preservation Committee (CPC) will hold its annual public hearing and information session on **Wednesday, May 12, 2021 at 3:00 p.m.** by remote participation on Zoom.

Pursuant to Massachusetts Governor Charles D. Baker's March 12, 2020 Order Suspending Certain Provisions of the Open Meeting Law, no in-person attendance of members of the public will be permitted, but the public is invited to participate in the online virtual meeting or watch the live stream on the Town of Yarmouth YouTube channel. Members of the public attending the online virtual meeting will be allowed to make comments if they wish to do so during the portion of the hearing designated for public comment. Every effort will be made to ensure that the public can adequately access the proceedings in real time, via technological means. In the event that we are unable to do so, despite best efforts, we will post on the town's website an audio or video recording, transcript, or other comprehensive record of proceedings as soon as possible after the meeting.

The public is invited to attend to hear about past project successes and to share ideas on how we can improve our community in the areas of **Community Housing, Historic Preservation, Open Space, and Recreation**. There is approximately \$5 million available in Community Preservation Act funds for eligible projects.
