1. Discussion with DPW Director

Jeff Colby, DPW Director, delivered a few DPW updates to the committee. First it was explained that the DPW would be funding the Beautification Team out of their operating budget this year. Committee members agreed to leave the \$20,000 for funding of a Beatification Team in place, in case there was an opportunity to fund an additional litter-pickup team. It was noted that it was very challenging to attract seasonal workers and it's possible these positions are unable to be filled. Mr. Colby also presented the report on the drainage issues at the Yarmouth Port Common. He explained that there was no clear, easy, and cheap solution to solving the drainage issues at this location, although a few options were presented in the report. Committee members agreed to review the report outside of the meeting and send any comments/suggested next steps to town staff for their consideration.
