Notice of Public Hearing

The Yarmouth Conservation Commission will conduct a public hearing for the purpose of soliciting comment on new stormwater regulations. The regulations are mandated by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency pursuant to the Clean Water Act. Small cities and towns in Massachusetts are required to enact such regulations that control the quality and quantity of stormwater that will ultimately find its way to “Navigable Waters of the United States” via stormwater control structures.

The public hearing regarding the above will be conducted at the Yarmouth Town Hall in the downstairs hearing room on **September 4, 2008 at 7:00 pm**. Draft copies of the proposed regulations may be viewed at the Yarmouth Conservation Commission Office at the Town Hall.
