FINAL Policies associated with COVID-19 Order No. 35
As Voted Tuesday, June 9, 2020

Outdoor Seating – The Yarmouth Board of Selectmen, hereby authorize the Building Commissioner to make relevant zoning determinations and to issue temporary zoning relief for outdoor dining at existing restaurants and eating/drinking establishments per COVID-19 Order No. 35. The Building Commissioner’s decision may be conditioned. The Building Commissioner’s decision may be appealed in writing to the Board of Selectmen Licensing Chairman within three (3) days of the issuance of the Building Commissioner’s decision. There shall not be a fee associated with the application, and the Board of Selectmen shall waive fees associated with tents or other structures to accommodate outdoor seating. All decisions shall be clocked in with the Town Clerk. No recording or other notifications are required.

Alcohol – Pursuant to COVID-19 Order No. 35, the Yarmouth Board of Selectmen, as the Local Licensing Authority, hereby authorize the Town Administrator to review and approve applications to permit the outdoor sale of alcoholic beverages for on premise consumption by amending the description of the licensed premises for existing license holders. No public meeting, abutter notification or legal advertisement will be required. The Town Administrator shall record all decisions with the Town Clerk and provide copies of the same to the ABCC. The Board of Selectmen shall waive fees associated with the application for a change in premise application related to the COVID-19 Order No. 35.
