





COMPACTOR	OCC	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* OCC = OLD CORROGATED CARDBOARD</li> <li>* All clean <b>corrugated</b> cardboard must be recycled</li> </ul> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Flatten, fold, or break down <b>corrugated</b> cardboard</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Food-soiled cardboard</li> <li>* Food *</li> <li>Cereal, tissue boxes (see mixed paper)</li> </ul>
	NEWSPAPER	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* NEWSPAPERS ONLY</li> </ul> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Please place newspaper and any newspaper advertisements in the NEWSPAPER container</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* All non-newspaper and other items included with newspaper are MIXED PAPER</li> </ul>
	MIXED PAPER	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* MIXED PAPER is all non newspaper items, including cereal, tissue, and non corrugated boxes, office paper, envelopes, brown paper bags etc.</li> </ul> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* See list below for items that can be placed in the Mixed Paper container</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Paper items that are wet or contaminated by food can be placed in the Mixed Paper container</li> <li>* Used napkins, towels, tissues, plates, cups * Wax paper *</li> <li>Cartons with wax coating *</li> <li>Paper take out containers *</li> <li>Shredded paper SEE LIST ON THE OTHER SIDE OF THIS PAGE</li> </ul>
METAL	SCRAP METAL	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Scrap metal container is available for those with a sticker, to deposit metal items that will fit within the openings</li> </ul> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Scrap metal includes steel, iron, lead, aluminium, copper, stainless steel and zinc.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Fire extinguishers</li> <li>* Propane tanks. (See Scale)</li> <li>* Light bulbs. *</li> <li>Metal gas cans *</li> <li>AC's, dehumidifiers, refrigerators (See Scale)</li> </ul>

1. PLEASE DO NOT put shredded paper in recycle bin. (JAMS THE MACHINES)
2. Deposit bottles can be donated at the Charitable Redemption Center shed.
3. If unsure where to place an item, feel free to ask a friendly Gate attendant or Recycler.
4. PLASTIC BAGS ARE NOT RECYCLABLE at the Disposal Area, please returned to supermarkets.
5. This document is a work in progress, the recycling world is changing, please check back for updates.

Greeting cards	<b>MATTRESSES</b>	Shredded paper
Lottery tickets	See Scale Attendant \$	GIFT Wrapping paper
Junk Mail (remove all samples)	<b>TV &amp; COMPUTERS</b>	Sanitizing Wipes
Mat board: used in picture framing	See Scale Attendant \$	<b>SEE ATTENDANT</b>
Math paper, graph and ledger, etc.	<b>PROPANE TANK</b>	Fluorescent tubes & bulbs
Office and copy paper	See Scale Attendant \$	Mercury-bearing items & batteries
Packing paper	<b>FREON APPLIANCES</b>	<b>BOOKS</b>
Paper: lined and white	See Scale Attendant \$	Books in Discovery Book bin
Paper: fax	<b>ALL LARGE METAL</b>	<b>COMPOST AT HOME</b>
Paper bags: brown and white	See Scale Attendant \$	Fruit peelings and cores
Paper bags with handles	<b>TIRES</b>	Vegatable peelings
Paper towel and toilet paper TUBES	See Scale Attendant \$	Eggshells
Post it notes	<b>BRUSH</b>	Coffee grinds
Writing tablets (without metal spiral)	See Scale Attendant \$	Leaves and yard clippings
